Eucharist on Earth: A Foretaste of Your Resurrection Life



“For **when they rise** from the dead, they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are **like angels** in heaven.” (Mk 12/25). “Instead of these things you gave your people the **food of angels**,...” (Wisdom 16: 20). “Yet he commanded the skies above, and opened the doors of heaven; and he rained down upon them manna to eat, and gave them the bread of heaven. **Man ate of the bread of the angels**; he sent food in abundance. (Psalms 78:23 – 25). “**I am the living bread that came down from heaven**; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live for ever; and the bread which I shall give for the life of the world is my flesh.” (Jn 6:51)

Jesus is the bread from heaven, given to us for our life. Is it not so wonderful that we are able to have while on the earth? St. John Chrisostom is reported to have said that ‘when angels behold it, they tremble and dare not look up without awe - yet we are fed with the same mystery and made one body and flesh.’ This does not mean you must approach with fear that paralyses; it means you must approach with faithful attention - seeing Christ truly present and therefore receiving with devotion. Yes, we should so approach the altar of the Lord with awe and wonder. The holy communion should remind us of this wonder and should transform us into living like angels.

In the Holy Communion the Lord extends an angelic communion to his children - participation in the heavenly worship where angels adore and praise God—especially as they are gathered around the risen Christ and the

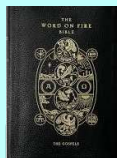
